Summary

Provide interventions that address women specific issues for adult, substance using women, pregnant women and women with dependent children and their families; provide evaluations and assessments, group and individual counseling for diverse populations including pregnant women, women with dependent children, IV drug users, individuals involved with DHS, probation and other court involvement. Reduce barriers and improve access to services and recovery. Identify client's needs for prenatal care, mental health care/evaluation, substance abuse counseling, housing, DV shelter, TANF, and making appropriate referrals. Aiding in the process of child protection in substance abusing homes; utilize treatment approaches that implement ethical, culturally competent, and evidence based practices.

Minimum Requirements – Education and Credentials

- Minimum CAC II, Bachelors Degree in counseling or related field
- Prefer Master's degree in counseling, social work, or related behavioral health field (M.A., M.S., MSW, MFT); Licensed Clinician (LCSW, LPC, LMFT in good standing in the state of Colorado.
- Two year experience in human service field

Minimum Requirements – Knowledge, Skills, Experience and Abilities

- Some background/experience in working with women and gender specific treatment.
- Knowledge of FASD and impact of other prenatal drug exposures.
- Sufficient language skills to be able to communicate both verbally and in writing to accurately and professionally implement and document the services provided to clients.
- Basic computer skills / good typing skills.
- Experience using various treatment modalities, including motivational interviewing , cognitive behavioral therapy and trauma informed care.
- Ability to be empathetic.
- Ability to maintain professional client/counselor boundaries.
- Experience working in a team environment.
- Bilingual English/Spanish a plus.
- Strong knowledge of community resources.
